

Poker Hands in Order (Highest to Lowest)

1. **Royal Flush** – A, K, Q, J, 10 of the same suit.
2. **Straight Flush** – Five consecutive cards of the same suit (e.g., 5-6-7-8-9 of hearts).
3. **Four of a Kind** – Four cards of the same rank (e.g., four 7s).
4. **Full House** – Three cards of one rank and two cards of another rank (e.g., three 10s and two Jacks).
5. **Flush** – Five cards of the same suit, not in sequence (e.g., all spades).
6. **Straight** – Five consecutive cards of any suit (e.g., 4-5-6-7-8).
7. **Three of a Kind** – Three cards of the same rank (e.g., three Kings).
8. **Two Pair** – Two sets of pairs (e.g., two 8s and two Queens).
9. **One Pair** – Two cards of the same rank (e.g., two 5s).
10. **High Card** – If no other hand is made, the highest card wins (e.g., Ace high).
